HAMPDEN COMMEMORATION,
ON CHALGROVE FIELD

On Monday, the 19th JUNE 1843 a DINNER (Lord Nugent in the Chair) will take place on CHALGROVE FIELD, in commemoration of the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the Chalgrove Fight, (at which John Hampden received his death wound,) and of the dedication of a monument to be raised in that place to the memory of Hampden. The company will assemble at one o'clock, when the marble portrait will be lifted in its place on the monument, and the dinner will be on table at three.
